

The U14s play at **Killinghall Moor Community Park, Harrogate.**

**From the A1**

Take the A59 to the Harrogate junction (47). Turn left on the A59 to Harrogate.

Stay on the Harrogate Bypass. IGNORE THE SIGN AT THE THIRD ROUNDABOUT FOR HARROGATE TOWN CENTRE. At the NEXT (fourth) roundabout, turn right towards Harrogate.

You will come to another major roundabout, with the Stray either side of you. Go straight on.

You will eventually come to the town centre and go down a hill towards a major crossroads. You will see the International Conference Centre on your right-hand side. Go straight through these lights and you will soon go back up another hill.

Once you start going down again, stay in the left hand lane. You will come to a set of lights. Turn left into Jennyfield Drive (you will see the Hydro Swimming Pool on your right hand side).

Carry on up Jennyfield Drive for about half a mile. You will see a sign on the left for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Saltergate Drive.

Continue up Saltergate Drive until you see another sign for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Barberry Close.

Continue up Barberry Close and turn first left again into the KMCP car park. There is plenty of parking.

**From the South A61**

After the bridge at Harewood (with the Sawmill on your left) there is a roundabout approximately 3 miles on. This is the main roundabout for the Bradford Road (left) and Harrogate Bypass (right). GO STRAIGHT ON.

You will come to another major roundabout, with the Stray either side of you. Go straight on.

You will eventually come to the town centre and go down a hill towards a major crossroads. You will see the International Conference Centre on your right-hand side. Go straight through these lights and you will soon go back up another hill.

Once you start going down again, stay in the left hand lane. You will come to a set of lights. Turn left into Jennyfield Drive (you will see the Hydro Swimming Pool on your right hand side).

Carry on up Jennyfield Drive for about half a mile. You will see a sign on the left for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Saltergate Drive.

Continue up Saltergate Drive until you see another sign for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Barberry Close.

Continue up Barberry Close and turn first left again into the KMCP car park. There is plenty of parking.

### **From the North A61**

After going through Killinghall, continue towards Harrogate. You will come to a roundabout. This is known as the Little Wonder Roundabout, as The Little Wonder pub is straight-ahead of you (about 11 o'clock). GO STRAIGHT ON HERE.

Go along about a quarter of a mile. You will come to a set of lights, just after a petrol station. TURN RIGHT here in to Jennyfield Drive. You will see the HYDRO swimming pool on your right-hand side.

Carry on up Jennyfield Drive for about half a mile. You will see a sign on the left for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Saltergate Drive.

Continue up Saltergate Drive until you see another sign for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Barberry Close.

Continue up Barberry Close and turn first left again into the KMCP car park. There is plenty of parking.

### **From the A59 (Skipton Road).**

Go right to the end of Skipton Rd and you will come to a roundabout. This is known as the Little Wonder Roundabout, as The Little Wonder pub is on your right-hand side (about 1 o'clock). There is a gas tank directly on your right. TURN RIGHT here.

Go along about a quarter of a mile. You will come to a set of lights, just after a petrol station. TURN RIGHT here in to Jennyfield Drive. You will see the HYDRO swimming pool on your right-hand side.

Carry on up Jennyfield Drive for about half a mile. You will see a sign on the left for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Saltergate Drive.

Continue up Saltergate Drive until you see another sign for Killinghall Moor Community Park. Turn left into Barberry Close.

Continue up Barberry Close and turn first left again into the KMCP car park. There is plenty of parking.
