



Disciplinary Procedures Policy for Killinghall Nomads Junior Football Club

In the event of a player engaging in activities deemed to be inappropriate as defined by the club code of conduct the following disciplinary procedures will be implemented:

In the first instance the player will be asked to desist and will be given a verbal warning by the manager or coach in attendance.

Should the behaviour continue the manager will inform the player's parent or guardian at the end of the session or by telephone.

If deemed necessary the player can be sanctioned for a period of up to two weeks by the team manager. The manager is responsible for informing the club secretary and parent or guardian of any sanctions.

If the behaviour persists into further sessions, the player's manager can further suspend the player but is to report the incident to the club secretary. The club secretary will be responsible for informing the club committee and then upon the decision of the committee informing the player's parent or guardian that their child is being given an official warning or in the event of exceptional circumstances, a player's membership could be terminated.

Membership fees are not refundable.
